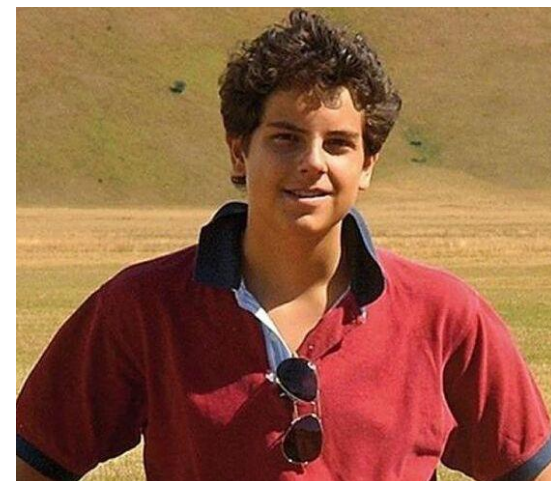

November is the month we traditionally remember those who have died and gone before us. It is a work of mercy to pray for our dead. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life, but have not yet attained the joys of heaven. St Paul warns us that we must not be ignorant concerning the dead, nor sorrowful, “even as others who have no hope ... For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven ... and the dead who are in Christ shall rise.”



Blessed Carlo Acutis was beatified in Assisi, Italy on 10 October 2020. An English-born Italian Catholic schoolboy and amateur computer programmer, he was a devout Catholic who went to Mass daily. He documented Eucharistic miracles around the world and catalogued them all on a website that he created in the months before his death from leukaemia at the age of 15.

The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Even in the Old Testament prayers and alms were offered for the souls of the dead by those who thought “well and religiously concerning the resurrection”. It was believed that “they who had fallen asleep with godliness had great grace laid up for them” and that “it is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins”. We know that a defiled soul cannot enter into heaven.

This year in the midst of such a terrible pandemic it would be good especially to pray for all of those who have died from Covid-19.

Below are several suggestions for praying for the dead.

Come to Mass on All Souls Day (2 November) at 9am or 8pm. Please make sure that anyone you wish to be remembered on that day has their name entered onto the appropriate list.

Have one of the weekday Masses offered for your departed. Please fill in one of the special November Requiem envelopes and hand it in.

Pray the **De Profundis** (text follows) every day for the faithful departed:

Out of the depths I have cried to thee, O Lord, Lord, hear my voice.

Let thy ears be attentive to the voice of my supplication.

If thou, O Lord, shalt observe iniquities, Lord, who shall endure it?

For with thee there is merciful forgiveness: and by reason of thy law.

I have waited for the, O Lord.

My soul hath relied on his word; my soul hath hoped in the Lord.

From the morning watch even until night, let Israel hope in the Lord.

Because with the Lord there is mercy, and with him plentiful redemption.

And he shall redeem Israel from all its iniquities.

V/ Eternal rest give unto them, O Lord.

R/ And let perpetual light shine upon them.

V/ May they rest in peace.

R/ Amen.

V/ O Lord, hear my prayer.

R/ And let my cry come unto thee.

Let us Pray:

O God, the Creator and Redeemer of all the faithful, grant to the souls of thy servants departed the remission of all their sins, that through our pious supplications they may obtain that pardon which they have always desired; Who livest and reignest world without end.

Amen.
